Position Summary

Applications are invited for two fixed-term academic posts lecturing in Art History whilst the current holders are on sabbatical leave. The successful candidates will be expected to offer modules in Art History on the BA and MA programmes and to supervise undergraduate and postgraduate dissertations.

Applicants should have previous experience in teaching at tertiary level, in supervising undergraduate and postgraduate dissertations, and a specialist knowledge of Irish art and local sources of research.
